

The rules for the use of materials and information published at nova.lc

1. These rules for the use of materials and information published on the nova.lc website, hence referred to as the Rules, determine the terms and conditions for the use of the said website.
2. All the materials, including texts, drawings, photos, videos, etc. published on the nova.lc website are duly registered intellectual property of NovaSoftware OÜ, registry number 14686567, and address: Majaka 26, 11412, Tallinn, Estonia.
3. Any kind of copying, storage, archiving and reproductions of paper or electronic versions of the materials from the nova.lc website without the written permission of the Copyright Holder is forbidden.
4. Reproduction of the website materials in other sources, i.e. on webpages, in media and on other information carriers is allowed only with the written permission of the Copyright Holder.
5. Graphic materials published on the nova.lc website may not be freely used similarly to other materials permanently available for reading because of their commercial nature.
6. Text materials published on nova.lc that contain direct or indirect reference to the company Nova and/or Novasoftware as well as graphic materials mentioning Nova and/or Novasoftware as Copyright Holder may be used on the following conditions:
 - 6.1. on a contractual basis;
 - 6.2. provided that such a use is for personal purposes only, except for the cases prescribed by law, material may be used without consent of the Copyright Holder and without paying a royalty.
 - 6.3. in the following cases, material may be used without the consent of the Copyright Holder, without paying a royalty but with an obligatory reference to the Copyright Holder, :
 - citation of materials or parts thereof in the original and in translation for scientific, polemical, critical or informational purposes in an amount justified by the purpose of the citation, including parts of text materials;
 - using the materials and their parts as illustrations in print media, in radio and television shows, audio and video recordings of an educational nature, in the amounts appropriate for the purpose of such a use;
 - reproduction in the print media, in live or cable broadcasting of public political speeches, statements, reports or other similar announcements in the amounts appropriate for the purpose of such a use;
 - reproductions or announcements as public information in current affairs reviews by means of photography, cinematography, live or cable broadcasting of materials and segments thereof which can be seen or heard during such shows in the amount appropriate for the informational purpose;
 - non-profit reproduction of materials by relief points or by other special means for the visually challenged.
7. When using the materials according to these Rules in print media, books or on other material carriers (paper, film, etc.), the User shall refer to nova.lc.
8. When using the materials according to these Rules in electronic media, on webpages, in electronic files or in other electronic formats, the User shall provide a hyperlink to the webpage of nova.lc.
9. Links and hyperlinks required by these Rules shall be placed by the User in the first paragraph of the text where the text materials are used or directly under the graphic material. The font size of a link or a hyperlink shall be of the same size as that of the User's font in the text where the materials are used or as the font of the User's text attached to the graphic material.
10. When using the materials according to these Rules in audio or video recordings, not limited to television and radio broadcasts, computer and phone network broadcasts or other similar formats, the User shall, in every case of a use, refer to nova.lc webpage as the source of information. The reference should be provided within a time interval not exceeding one minute from the beginning of the use of the material in the User's audio or video recording and the sound volume of the reference shall be the same as that of the main audio-video material employed by the User where the Copyright Holder's materials are used.

11. When using the materials in the ways herein outlined, no re-processing of the materials is allowed except for shortening of the text materials. Text materials may be shortened only in ways that do not distort their meaning. No alteration and/or processing of graphic materials is allowed.
12. These Rules, as well as the placement of the contract on the Internet, may not be construed as a contract or as an offer, including a public one. In order to use the materials according to clause 5.1 hereof a written contract is required. For information about the contractual use of the materials please contact the Copyright Holder using the contact information provided.
13. The Copyright Holder and the webpage administrators may change and/or extend these Rules without giving prior notice to Users. The Rules may be changed and/or extended by uploading their new version, which comes into force upon its publishing on the website.
14. In the case of violation of any of these Rules, individually or in any combination, the Copyright Holder and the webpage administration may resort to legal remedies including court actions.
